- Determine variety and volume of seed requested.
- Estimate air freight or container freight to customer desired port of entry.
- Obtain Import Permit from importing country's government agency.
- Seller obtains Phytosanitary certificate.
- Buyer performs a wire transfer of funds prior to shipment.
- Hancock Seed Co., Inc. loads container and air freight with supervision of a USDA agent.
- Copies of all documents and certifications are provided to freight company and buying agent prior to shipment.
- Shipment is sent to customer.
